

Eveleth Comprehensive Plan Update

Public Input Meeting Summary
October 29th, 2008: 6:00 p.m.
Eveleth City Hall



1. Welcome and Introductions

- ARDC staff (Ben VanTassel) opened the meeting and welcomed the attendees to the meeting. VanTassel explained the need for a comprehensive plan update. Also the development of the planning committee and what the process entails was explained. He also explained that the first step is to gather input from the public on what the assets and concerns of Eveleth are. VanTassel also explained that the more input gathered at the meeting would benefit the process greatly.

2. Asset Mapping

- The attendees were asked to gather around large maps that were spread around the room. Attendees were asked to look at the maps and develop lists of assets and concerns of the area, including ideas that could not be seen on the map. After enough time to develop long lists of assets and concerns the attendees were asked to voice their ideas in the large group. Josh Bergstad (ARDC) recorded all the information shared. VanTassel explained that these lists will be used throughout the process.

3. Vision Statement Development

- VanTassel then asked attendees to share their ideas for a vision of Eveleth. They were asked to finish the statement; in the future Eveleth will be... These ideas were recorded and will be used by the planning committee to formulate a vision for the Comprehensive Plan Update Process.
