Public feedback will help to develop special mitigation action projects for high-risk wildfire communities under consideration by Lake County, U.S. Forest Service, and Minnesota DNR such as development of a NOAA emergency radio program, metal roof grant program, education programs, hazardous fuel reduction treatments, and installation of dry hydrants & water storage tanks to improve fire responders' capacity to fight wildfire in remote areas. A presentation will be provided followed by discussion for public input.
